

## INFORMATION NOTICE PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF REG. (EU) 2016/679

Associazione Laicale Fraternità di Comunione e Liberazione has established an *International Master's Degree Prize* and a *Doctoral Degree Prize* for theses on the figure and work of Msgr. Luigi Giussani, reserved for graduates from all over the world who have obtained a master's degree and for PhDs who have obtained their degree from an Italian or foreign university (hereinafter the Initiative).

This notice governs and explains the processing of personal data as part of the Initiative.

The Owner of the processing of one's personal data is Associazione Laicale Fraternità di Comunione e Liberazione, with registered office in Milan, Via De Notaris 50, hereinafter referred to as Fraternità.

The personal data that are going to be processed are:

- personal data relating to the candidate and freely provided by him/her when submitting the application or included in the documents and/or material and/or papers provided in support of the application, or in any case in the context of the Initiative;
- personal data of third parties provided by the candidate that may be contained in the documents and/or material and/or papers provided in support of the application, or in any case in the context of the Initiative.

The above data may (or may not) include data belonging to special or sensitive categories pursuant to Article 9 of Reg. (EU) 2016/679 since, by the nature of these data or due to the connection of the present initiative to the person and work of Msgr. Luigi Giussani, they are capable of "*revealing (...)* the religious beliefs" of the persons concerned.

The provision of personal data is free and optional, but failure to provide them may preclude participation in the call for proposals or the awarding of the prize, depending on the case.

The purpose of processing personal data is:

- letting applicants participate in the call for proposals
- implementing the call for proposals by awarding the prize
- executing the agreement concluded between Fraternità and the person concerned as to the use that Fraternità can make of his/her paper (thesis).

The processing of the applicant's data is based:

- on the consent, expressed by signing the Application Form and this Information Notice, pursuant to Article 6 paragraph 1 letter a) of Reg. (EU) 2016/679.
- the agreement between the person concerned and Fraternità on the use that Fraternità can make of his/her paper (thesis) in accordance with Article 6 paragraph 1 letter b) of Reg. 2016/679.

Personal data will be processed:

- by persons duly appointed by Fraternità, as Holder, to the processing of personal data (e.g. secretarial staff, members of awarding commissions, etc.);
- by external subject who provide the Holder with additional services to the competition and the awarding of the prize.

As an international call, it being understood the Initiative and thus the processing takes place in Italy, where Fraternità has its headquarters, persons residing in foreign countries, even outside the

European Union area, in any country in the world, may be also involved in the processing of personal data.

With regard solely to the personal data contained in or relating to the candidates' theses, their diffusion will follow the same standard of publication and diffusion of the theses themselves, in accordance with the agreements concluded between the candidates and Fraternità, whereby any country in the world may be included.

With regard to any personal data of third parties provided by the candidate, the same are provided under the exclusive responsibility of the candidate himself/herself, who guarantees to Fraternità that he/she has lawfully collected them, that he/she has fulfilled all legal obligations that may be applicable to inform and collect the consent of the person involved, and that he/she is legitimately entitled to communicate them to Fraternità so that they may be processed in accordance with this Information Notice.

The retention period of personal data will vary according to the type of data.

All personal data contained in the theses of the interested parties or related to them, as well as personal data whose processing is necessary to execute the agreement between the interested party and Fraternità concerning the use of the work produced by the interested party with no time limits, will be kept and processed with no time limits by Fraternità within the scope of the aforementioned agreement and as integral part of the documentation of the institutional initiatives undertaken by Fraternità for the 100th Anniversary of the birth of Msgr. Luigi Giussani.

Further personal data will be processed for the time necessary to carry out the initiative and will then be deleted.

Article 13 paragraph 2 letter b), c) and d) of Reg. (EU) 2016/679, and Articles 15 to 18 and 20 to 21 of Reg. (EU) 2016/679, grant each person concerned, as to the processing of his or her personal data, that rights of access, rectification, restriction of processing, withdrawal of consent, recourse to the Data Protection Authority, data portability, cancellation and objection will be respected.
